CONTEXT AND GENERAL OBJECTIVES

The Teachers Forum of the European Schools (TFES) is an initiative that was launched by the Italian Presidency of the European Schools (2023-2024) in April 2024 in Parma, based on the recommendation of the European Parliament's Committee on Culture and Education. TFES provides an opportunity to unite national education systems with the European Schools System (ESS), allowing educators from both to share and exchange best practices and innovative teaching experiences on common subjects of interest.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

In accordance with the motto of the Cyprus Presidency, « $\Delta PA \equiv A\Sigma \Theta E \Pi AI \Delta EIA\Sigma$ » (DRAXASTHE PAIDEIAS | *en.* "Seize Education"), teachers and other stakeholders will have the opportunity to exchange best practices and innovative teaching ideas during the Teachers Forum of the European Schools 2025 (TFES2025). Within the framework of the following educational priorities of the Cyprus Presidency, TFES2025 will be a place to share these "Ideas Worth Seizing" through dedicated workshops and a Teachers Exhibition (see Call for Applications <u>here</u>*):

- (1) Improving the quality of the working environment and teachers' level of wellbeing;
- (2) Building a respectful and supportive school community for all pupils;
- (3) Looking at education as a critical implementation tool for sustainable development.

TARGET AUDIENCE

Educators, directors, deputy directors and inspectors serving in nursery, primary and secondary schools of the system of European Schools, in addition to teachers and education representatives of the Cyprus school system, as well as other local and international stakeholders.

WORKING LANGUAGE

The working language of TFES2025 is English. Interpretation will not be available.

LOCATION

TFES2025 will be held in Nicosia, the capital of Cyprus.

REGISTRATION AND TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

Registration is now open and can be completed here.

The deadline for registrations is the <u>10th of March 2025</u>.

We encourage early registrations as to secure a spot. Registrations will adhere to a 'first come first served policy'.

As participation is limited to 200 seats, a maximum number of registrations from each school is defined as follows: up to two (2) persons from managerial positions and up to three (3) teachers. Please note that <u>at least one (1) person from each school is required to be a teacher</u>.

REGISTRATION FEES

There are no registration fees for the TFES2025.

All lunches and coffee breaks on both days of the forum, in addition to a reception on Tuesday evening, will be offered by the Cyprus Presidency (see Preliminary Program <u>here</u>).

TRAVEL EXPENSES

Participants are responsible for their own travel expenses.

Please note that Cyprus is a popular destination in April. In order to ensure greatest availability, participants are strongly encouraged to arrange booking flights as soon as possible (proposed arrival date: Sunday, 06/04/2025).

ACCOMMODATION

Participants are responsible for booking their own accommodation. A significant number of rooms have been reserved on special rates exclusively for the TFES2025 (see Hotel Options here).
