As part of the retrospective exhibition Past-forward: Stavros Economou Unarchived, you are invited to an event of public talks and discussion on:

'Digital Tools and Practices of Engagement with Modern Architecture Heritage'

Re-using the building stock of our cities, including not only heritage but also buildings of the recent past, is a strategy for a sustainable future. Acknowledging this condition, the public discussion on 'Digital Tools and Practices of Engagement with Modern Architecture Heritage' will explore the capacities and affordances of digital methods and tools for the study and valorisation of Modern architecture. This is of particular importance today if we want our existing built environment to provide us with historic continuity for achieving more resilient cities. The discussion will consider the challenges of using state-of-the-art digital tools for the analysis and communication of the palimpsest of spatial identities attributed to examples of Modern architecture. Digital tools can facilitate the engagement of diverse communities who inhabit, associate with or avoid and neglect the building stock, in a dialogue with all stakeholders, offering views beyond the experts' who may promote a hegemonic narrative. The event will be steered by two parallel conversations, which will focus on academic and practice-led research conducted for pedagogical purposes, as well as for enabling participation in shared interpretations of architecture heritage.
